Livestock Event 2013: Bigger mixing buckets from Emily

French manufacturer Emily has extended its range of hydraulically-driven mixer buckets which now range from 1.0cu.m up to 7.0cu.m capacities.



Its larger models, above 4.6cu.m, are designed to be used with large telehandlers and loading shovels, it says. Each model can be specified with a grab or hydraulically-driven rotor for extracting material out of clamps.

Built with hardox steel to keep weight down and strength up, the largest machine weighs 2.5 tonnes (un-laden).
