Emily extends shear grab line-up

WITH a capacity starting from 0.6cu.m, Emily has extended its line-up of shear grabs, with machines now going up to 2cu.m capacity.

The new, larger models are designed for high capacity work, says the manufacturer, and need to be used with telehandlers and loading shovels with at least a 3.5-tonne lifting capacity. Price for a 2cu.m machine is about £8,000.

The firm has also updated its range of feeder/mixing buckets which range from 1cu.m to 4.6cu.m in capacity.

Available in two variants, the 50 model can handle mixes made up of 50 per cent grass silage, while the 100 can handle mixes of 100 per cent grass silage. This is down to a slightly different blade configuration.

To drive it, the hydraulic requirement is 60 litres per minute. Price for the 3.4cu.m capacity machine on show is about £12,000.
