

Emily Pick & Go bale unroller

Attachment manufacturer Emily has launched a round bale unroller which can be loaded and operated by one worker.

Suitable for all crop types and round bales of diameters from 1.0-1.8 metres, the Delta Pick & Go consists of two main parts – the bale unroller and the bale fork carrier.

It can work with various machines including telehandlers, wheeled loaders, front-end loaders or a tractor's linkage.

Tines

To work, the fork element is used to load the unroller. Once loaded, the two fork tines slide in under the unroller to carry the machine. When the tines are inserted, a hydraulically driven gear meshes with the machine's drive mechanism.

Hydraulic power, provided by the third service for example, is used to drive the unroller. A locking mechanism holds the fork and the unroller together.

The machine can be specified as right- or left-handed and discharges material via toothed slats, connected to two chains running around two rollers.
