Varied range of new technology on show at Livestock Event

A diverse range of new products, including some of the latest technology, for feeding, muck handling and producing forage crops, was on show at the Livestock Event.

Multidis bedding bucket from Emily



THE new Multidis bedding bucket from Emily can handle maize silage as well as spreading sand and sawdust, and holds up to 2.9cu.m of light materials.

Designed for mounting on a telehandler or tractor linkage, the bucket uses a hydraulically-driven rubber belt for high speed discharge, a patented design from the company's feeder bucket range said to eliminate bridging of material. The price is £5,500.

Emily also introduced the Pick and Go bale unroller which features a clever design whereby its frame can be used as a bale spike with the hydraulics already attached.

Once the bale is loaded, the unroller is quick coupled to the spike without disconnecting or reconnecting the hydraulics. Bales can be fed to the left or right and diameters of up to 1.8m (5ft 10in) can be accommodated. It is priced at £5,000.
